

Sword, Famine, and Drought

Jeremiah 14:1 to 15:21

608 BC During the eleven-year reign of Jehoiakim

The connection between **drought** and the enemy is very clear in this section. It encompasses a variety of speakers and audiences. But it begins with a description of the drought (see Cj - [Judah's Terrible Drought](#)) and ends with a description of defeat in battle (see Cl - [You Have Rejected Me, I am Tired of Relenting](#)), followed by Jeremiah's fourth complaint (see Cm - [Woe to Me, Mother, That You Gave Me Birth](#)). In between we hear of sword, famine, and drought (14:12).
